OVERVIEW AND TIMEFRAME:

Any teacher or administrator can earn Ashland Graduate Workshop Credit – 1, 2, or 3 credit hours – for completing professional development that is offered through the Stark County ESC, SPARCC, SST-9, ODE, district programs, online, or commercial offerings.

- Attend professional development. **NOTE:** At least 1 workshop or meeting must be Stark County ESC, SST-9, or SPARCC-sponsored.
- By July 31, 2025, complete and submit all required documents to the specific consultant below.
